## TASTING NOTES

Tart notes of red plum, cherry and blueberry are evident on the nose. The well-integrated oak provides sensations of dried fruit, creamy, apricot, peach and a tasty orange peel finish. Pair with salads, pasta, paella, fish and cheeses. Ideal for picnics, barbecues and summer parties.

## VINEYARDS

From our selected vineyards, the grapes of Tempranillo & Syrah are fermented in 16-hectoliter egg-shaped, concrete tanks, below 17°C/62°F to obtain this wonderful rosé. Then it is aged for 4 months in French oak barrels with the aim to produce a smooth and round mouth-feel.
