TASTING NOTES

Deep purple and perfectly balanced between maturity and freshness. On the palate it is initially juicy, with layers of black licorice, cherry, plum jam, toast, oak and cedar. Supple texture with a lingering and pleasant finish.

VINEYARDS

Hand-picked grapes, from small vineyard plots with low yields, are fermented separately in small vats. The juice is transferred into French oak barrels, mainly to complete the malolactic fermentation process, and the wine spends 10 months of maturing in the oak barrels.
