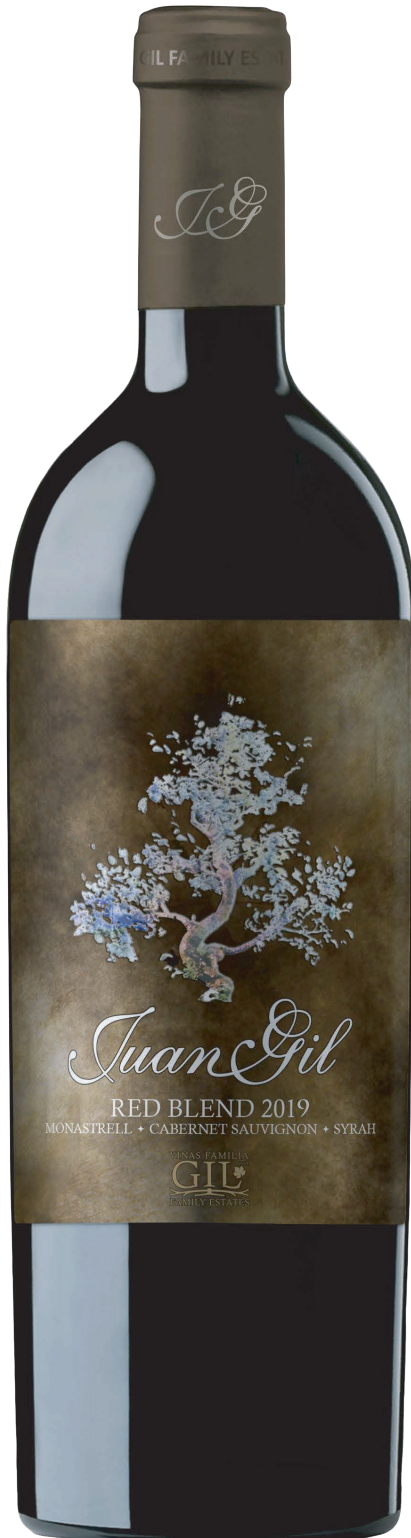

TASTING NOTES

Hints of spicy nuances that complement the ripe black and red berry aromas. A flash of sweet strawberries with dusty tannins on the medium-bodied palate with a fruity finish. Good balance and structure, this wine may be enjoyed now and has the components to drink well for a few years.

VINEYARDS

The vineyards are head-pruned, dry-farmed old vines planted at an average elevation of 2,000 feet above sea level. The yields are low and all hand-picked. No herbicides or pesticides are used in production. The wine spends 12-months in a selection of French and American oak barrels.
